HE HAS A BACHELORS DEGREE IN HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF DELAWARE. MIKE IS A NATIONAL AND STATE CERFIFIED EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICAN.

MIKE IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES LIFESAVING ASSOCIATION AND THE UNION REPRESENTATIVE FOR DEERFIELD OCEAN RESCUE.

IN THE AREA OF PUBLIC RELATIONS, HE IS AN EXCELLENT ROLE MODEL FOR THE YOUTH. HE IS AN INSTRUCTOR FOR OUR JUNIOR LIFEGUARD PROGRAM AND HEAD SWIM TEAM COACH FOR THE DEERFIELD DOLPHINS THAT NUMBER 165 SWIMMERS.

THE DELRAY BEACH OCEAN RESCUE DIVISION PROVIDES LIFEGUARD SUPERVISION TO A NEARLY ONE MILLION VISITORS ON ITS MILE OF BEACHFRONT. THE DIVISION HAS BEEN A UNITED STATES, LIFESAVING ASSOCIATION (U.S.L.A.) ADVANCED LIFEGUARD AGENCY CERTIFIED SINCE 1995. BECAUSE IT REQUIRES ITS STAFF TO BE STATE CERTIFIED EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS, IT CAN PROVIDE IMMEDIANTE BASIC LIFE SUPPORT TO ANY MEDICAL EMERGENCY.

THE STAFF ALSO PARTICIPATES IN LOCAL, NATIONAL,; AND INTERNATIONAL TOURNAMENTS INCLUDING: USLA COMPETITION (THE DELRAY BEACH COMPETITION TEAM PLACED FIRST AT 2001 U.S.L.A. NATIONAL LIFEGUARD TOURNAMENT - DIVISION 2, IN MIAMI, FLORIDA) AND CLINCON INTERNATIONAL B.L.S. COMPETITION. DELRAY ALSO HOSTS ITS OWN ANNUAL LIFEGUARD COMPETITION, OCEAN MILE SWIM, PADDLEBOARD RACE, AND B.L.S. EMERGENCY MEDICAL COMPETITION.

DELRAY BEACH IS VERY PROUD OF ITS YEAR ROUND JUNIOR LIFEGUARD PROGRAM, OCEAN RESCUE EXPLORER PROGRAM, POST 0311, AND ITS OCEAN AWARENESS BEACH AND WATER SAFETY PRESENTATIONS GIVEN TO 700 LOCAL SCHOOL STUDENTS THIS PAST YEAR.

THE DELRAY BEACH OCEAN RESCUE OFFICER EMT'S AND OPERATIONS SUPERVISORS ALSO BECAME THE FIRST LIFEGUARD AGENCY IN THE COUNTRY TO BE REPRESENTED BY INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF FIRE-FIGHTERS UNION.

FLORIDA BEACH PATROL CHIEFS ASSOCIATION LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

WILLIAM McNEELY, JR.

BILL HAS DEVOTED HIS ENTIRE ADULT LIFE TO WATER SAFETY. HE BEGAN LIFEGUARDING IN 1969, IN HIS HOME STATE OF NEBRASKA. IN 1973, AFTER GRADUATING FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA, WHERE HE WAS A VARSITY SWIMMER, BILL CAME TO FLORIDA TO ATTEND HARDHAT DEEP-SEA DIVING AND UNDERWATER PHOTOGRAPHY SCHOOLS. HE EARNED CERTIFICATIONS AS A D.T.A. DEEP-SEA LOCKOUT DIVER AND P.A.D.I. SCIENCE RESEARCH DIVER. HE ALSO HOLDS SCUBA CERTIFICATES FROM N.A.S.D.S. AND N.A.U.I. BILL IS ALSO A CERTIFIED RESCUE BOAT OPERATOR, A.R.C. INSTRUCTOR TRAINER AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN. THE WORLD LIFESAVING ORGANIZATION APPROVED BILL AS AN INTERNATIONAL TRAINING OFFICER IN 1994. BILL IS ONE OF ONLY FOUR PERSONS IN THE COUNTRY TEACHING U.S.L.A. LIFESAVING ON A COLLEGE LEVEL.

ST. LUCIE COUNTY HIRED BILL AS AN OCEAN LIFEGUARD AND SWIMMING INSTRUCTOR IN 1974. TWO YEARS LATER, HE WAS PROMOTED TO BEACH PATROL CAPTAIN AND AQUATICS SUPERVISOR. BILL WAS HONORED AS THE 1988 ST. LUCIE COUNTY RECREATION WORKER OF THE YEAR. IN 1998, HE BECAME THE AQUATICS AND SAFETY SUPERINTENDENT, WHICH INCLUDED DUTIES OF SCHEDULING AND OPERATION OF VESSELS, INSPECTIONS OF PROPERTIES AND FACILITIES, STUDY AND DEVELOPMENT OF ARTIFICIAL REEFS. HIS TITLES INCLUDED DISASTER COORDINATOR, INFORMATION OFFICER FOR NUCLEAR EMERGENCIES FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT AND SPECIAL DEPUTY. SHERIFF. CHIEF MONEELY RETIRED IN 1999. IN 1978 BILL JOINED THE NATIONAL SURF LIFESAVING ASSOCIATION, WHICH LATER EVOLVED INTO THE UNITED STATES LIFESAVING ASSOCIATION. BILL WAS THE SOUTHEAST REGION TREASURER FOR SIX YEARS AND PRESIDENT FOR FIVE YEARS. HE HAS ATTENDED THIRTY U.S.L.A. NATIONAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETINGS, ALL AT HIS OWN EXPENSE. BILL HAS BEEN A F.B.P.C.A. MEMBER SINCE 1993.

BILL WAS THE VICE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ST. LUCIE COUNTY CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN RED CROSS FROM 1982 THROUGH 1988. BILL WAS A MEMBER OF THE FT. PIERCE UNITY CHURCH BOARD OF DIRECTORS FROM 1990 THROUGH 1999 AND SERVED AS ITS PRESIDENT FROM 1997 THROUGH 1999. BILL WAS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE INTERNATIONAL LIFESAVING INSTITUTE, AND IS THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AQUATIC RESCUE EDUCATION FOUNDATION. HE IS A RECIPIENT OF THE COMMANDER LONGFELLOW SOCIETY AWARD, THE INTERNATIONAL SWIMMING HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTOR AWARD AND THE U.S.L.A. SERVICE AWARD.

AS A SWIM COACH, BILL TRAINED SEVEN HIGH SCHOOL AND SIXTY JUNIOR COLLEGE ALLAMERICANS. HE WAS INDUCTED INTO THE ST. LUCIE COUNTY SPORTS HALL OF THE FAME IN 1998,

DURING LAST YEAR'S NATIONAL BEACH SAFETY WEEK, BILL GAVE TWENTY WATER SAFETY LECTURES TO DAY CARE CENTERS, BOY SCOUTS, GIRL SCOUTS, BIG BROTHERS, BIG SISTERS, AND CHURCH GROUPS, TOTALING FIVE HUNDRED ATTENDEES. HE GAVE AWAY FIFTY WATER SAFETY VIDEOS.

TODAY, BILL RUNS THE LIGHTHOUSE SWIMMING SCHOOL. HE TEACHES SIX HUNDRED STUDENTS PER YEAR, (13,200+ LIFETIME) FROM INFANTS TO ADULTS, IN COURSES OF SWIMMING, JUNIOR LIFIGUARDING AND SCUBA. HE STILL VOLUNTEERS FOR THE A.R.C. AS AN INSTRUCTOR TRAINER. HE IS WORKING ON THE U.S.L.A. NATIONAL PUBLIC EDUCATION COMMITTEE PROJECT ENTITLED, "A PARENT'S GUIDE TO BEACH SAFETY", AND THE F.B.P.C.A. "LIGHTNING FACTS AND PRECAUTIONS" POSTER.

THE BEACH "CHIEFS" FORMED IN 1983 TO PROMOTE PROFESSIONALISM WITHIN FLORIDA'S OCEAN LIFESAVING AGENCIES. THE FOUNDING MEMBERS RECOGNIZED THE NEED FOR INCREASED COOPERATION AND COMMUNICATION AMONG FLORIDA'S PROFESSIONAL OCEAN LIFEGUARDS. WORTHWHILE PROJECTS BEGAN TO EMERGE FROM THE "CHIEFS" INCLUDING PUBLIC EDUCATION. PROMOTING LEGISLATION RELATED TO OCEAN LIFESAVING AND RAISING STANDARDS OF TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION. THE LIFEGUARD OF THE YEAR AND BEACH PATROL OF THE YEAR AWARDS WERE CREATED TO HONOR THE BEST LIFEGUARDS AND LIFEGUARD AGENCIES IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA.

THE PRIMARY GOAL OF U.S.L.A. IS
TO, "ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN HIGH
STANDARDS OF PROFESSIONAL SURF AND
OPEN WATER LIFESAVING FOR THE
MAXIMIZING OF PUBLIC SAFETY." AS SUCH,
U.S.L.A. LEADERS HAVE LONG WORKED TO
STANDARDIZE TRAINING AND LIFESAVING
PRACTICES THROUGHOUT THE UNITED
STATES THROUGH VARIOUS MEANS.

THERE ARE NOW OVER 100 CHAPTERS OF THE U.S.L.A. EACH IS AFFILIATED WITH A LOCAL LIFESAVING SERVICE OR SERVICES AND COMPOSED OF EMPLOYEES OF THOSE AGENCIES. THE CHAPTERS FORM REGIONS, OF WHICH THERE ARE EIGHT. EACH U.S.L.A. REGION HAS A PRESIDENT AND ITS OWN BOARD OF DIRECTORS. THE NATIONAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE U.S.L.A., ELECTED EVERY TWO YEARS, IS MADE UP OF DELEGATES SENT BY EACH REGION TO BI-ANNUAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETINGS. WITHIN CERTAIN GUIDELINES, REGIONAL REPRESENTATION ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS IS PROPORTIONAL TO REGIONAL MEMBERSHIP LEVELS.

THROUGHOUT ITS HISTORY THE U.S.L.A.
HAS BEEN AN ORGANIZATION OF
LIFEGUARDS FOR LIFEGUARDS, IMPROVING
THEIR PROFESSION AND THE SAFETY OF
THE BEACH-GOING PUBLIC. DEDICATED
MEMBERS VOLUNTEER THEIR TIME AND
ACCOMPLISH THE WORK OF THE
ORGANIZATION.
