BEACH PATROL OF THE YEAR - 2009

Indian River County Ocean Rescue is celebrating its 37th year. Indian River County Ocean Rescue protects the public year-round at five county parks located throughout the county. At the south end of the county is Round Island, a true multi-use park. Mid-county is Tracking Station, a favorite of Vero residents. At the north end are three parks within a three mile stretch of beach: Wabasso, Golden Sands, and Treasure Shores. Each of these parks has its own unique qualities and pleasures for beach goers, as well as challenges for the lifesavers of Indian River County.

Indian River County Ocean Rescue adheres to the philosophy that preventive action, effective rescue, and quality on-scene emergency medical care are the primary responsibilities of a great lifesaving operation. All full time lifeguards are required to be state certified EMTs. All lifeguard towers are double covered throughout the year. Indian River County Ocean Rescue has a near perfect public safety record, the only recorded death in a guarded swimming area having occurred in 1989.

Although the size of our operation is smaller than most, Indian River County Ocean Rescue strives to offer the same quality of public safety service found in larger operations. Indian River County lifeguards have been active, individually and collectively, in USLA and FBPCA meetings and events. We continue to mentor young lifesavers with a successful junior lifeguard program.

The sixteen ocean rescue lifeguards of Indian River County are honored to have been named "BEACH PATROL OF THE YEAR." We dedicate this award to the memory of Bob Woyshner, who left us too soon.

PRESIDENTS AWARD for OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTIONS TO OCEAN LIFESAVING RECIPIENT: FT. LAUDERDALE OCEAN RESCUE

Fort Lauderdale Ocean Rescue has a rich tradition of surf lifesaving dating back to 1926. Today, this United States Lifesaving Association Certified Agency of nearly 100 staff provides public safety to 3 miles of continuous beachfront from 20 permanent towers and as many as 10 temporary auxiliary stands. Daily operations on the beach oversee an estimated 4 million visitors each year using an array of equipment and resources including: off road trucks and ATV's, 2 Personal Rescue Water Craft, AED's, King Airway Adjuncts, various buoys, paddleboards and medical equipment. While Fort Lauderdale year in and year out contributes to professional ocean lifesaving, this year was truly a standout year. The year 2009 brought the USLA National Championships to Ft Lauderdale, a huge undertaking which challenges even the largest agencies in the Country. The staff not only staged the competition, they won the National Championship, Division B. Other accomplishments include: 2009 USLA/SER Sprint Series Competition Champions and 2009 BLS Competition Series Champions. It is therefore my honor to acknowledge Fort Lauderdale Ocean Rescue with the FBPCA 2009 Presidents Award, "In Recognition for Your Agencies Outstanding Contributions to Professional Ocean Lifesaving."

F.B.P.C.A. LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

RECIPIENT: JOE LAIN - CLEARWATER BEACH OCEAN RESCUE

In 1985 my wife and I moved from St. Thomas in the US Virgin Islands to Clearwater, Florida. We picked Clearwater out on the map. Neither of us had been here before. Anyway, I quickly got a job as a lifeguard and was promoted to Chief a couple years later. I retired May 8, 2009. During my tenure we became one of the first 50 USLA certified agencies in the Country, overcoming one obstacle after another. At our highpoint, we employed 45 lifeguards and truly felt we were heading in the right direction. In 2003, Clearwater was recognized as the Florida Beach Patrol of the Year. Our competition teams were very competitive during the past 10 years and our Jr. Lifeguard Program and Ocean Mile Swim Series were very successful. I'm not sure if I deserve a Lifetime Achievement Award, but am very grateful and honored. If intent has anything to do with it, perhaps my career is noteworthy. I enjoyed every minute and quite honestly feel truly honored to be an Ocean Lifeguard.

U.S.L.A. S.E.R. LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECIPIENT: KEVIN TILLMAN – PALM BEACH COUNTY

Born in Maryland, Kevin and his family relocated to Daytona Beach in 1970. At 19, Kevin began his lifeguard career for Volusia County in 1977. In 1979, he left Daytona and worked eight years for Pompano Beach. All the while, Kevin worked hard to hone both his lifesaving and competition skills.

In 1989, he joined Palm Beach County Ocean Rescue, where he remained for the rest of his career. At the 1996 Nationals, Kevin took 1st in the Paddleboard. At the 2002 World Lifesaving Championships, Kevin was crowned WORLD CHAMPION in the two kilometer Beach Run. Kevin's lifeguard skills went beyond competition; he was honored by the city of Boca Raton for a dramatic, life saving rescue and he helped solve a beach related murder during his career. His accomplishments earned Kevin the nickname, "The Tillmanator"!

During Kevin's seventeen years with Palm Beach County, he was the most consistent performer on the competition team. His team spirit and top placing in multi events are legend. He competed in over 70 invitational Florida competitions, 14 Regionals, 13 Nationals and 1 World Championship! His lifeguard career may have been cut short by a tragic accident which left him in a coma for over three weeks, but Kevin's spirit is inextinguishable! He is one of the most recognized, respected and well liked lifeguards in Florida. His warm heart and easy going nature endears him to all who know him.
